

General Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement

During the course of my studies at the University of Cambridge, I am likely to discuss and have access to information, technology and ideas that various organisations participating in the programme and the University regard as confidential.

I agree for the benefit of participating organisations and the University of Cambridge that I will make all reasonable efforts to hold in strict confidence any Information, technologies and ideas that I am told in advance are confidential, and will not copy, reveal or disclose such Information, technology and ideas to any third party and that I will not use any such information, technology and ideas for my own benefit or the benefit of any organisation with which I am affiliated now or in the future. I also agree to abide by such other rules and guidelines that Cambridge Judge Business School or the University of Cambridge may reasonably impose.

This Agreement shall not apply to any information, technology and ideas which:

1. at the date of this Agreement are in the public domain or subsequently come into the public domain through no fault of mine;
2. were already known to me on the date of disclosure, provided that such prior knowledge can be substantiated;
3. properly and lawfully become available to me from sources independent of the supplying party;
4. are disclosed pursuant to the requirement or request of a governmental agency provided that in such event I shall inform you of the nature and extent of any disclosure so required.

This Agreement shall come into effect from the date below and the obligations under this Agreement shall remain in effect for a period of three (3) years.

This Agreement shall be subject to English law.
