








The IGNITE programme is open to participants from all over the world and across a range of technology sectors, disciplines and emerging technologies with innovative ideas that have the potential to impact on all sectors of society.

Delegates will benefit from hearing and engaging with all the ideas brought to IGNITE and the cross-pollination and networking that is facilitated throughout the week.

- Students, graduates, researchers or academics conducting research in emerging technologies with commercial potential and who are considering starting their own venture.
- Entrepreneurs and founders of existing young businesses looking for a unique immersive experience to help them ignite their next steps and develop an actionable business plan
- Corporate intrapreneurs and innovators who want to test or develop new products or services or spin out a company, and build the new networks needed to support this activity.

IGNITE is five and a half days of immersive entrepreneurial education and training delivered by the faculty at the Cambridge Judge Business School supported by industry specialists, investors and entrepreneurs drawn from the world-famous Cambridge ecosystem.

Faculty keynotes and practical teaching sessions based on cutting edge research and best practices are augmented by daily mentoring sessions, one-toone clinics and the opportunity to pitch at the end of the programme to experts who provide feedback on the all-important next steps.



# APPLYING FOR IGNITE 2023

The annual IGNITE programme runs from Sunday 2 July to Friday 7 July 2023. We encourage you to apply as early as possible to allow us to consider your application and invite the most beneficial mentors and contributors to the programme for you.

## Eligibility criteria:

Your idea will be assessed by The Entrepreneurship Centre for:

- Innovation and novelty
- Sustainability
- Stage of venture (not very early but not too advanced either)
- 'Tech' products or ideas are highly suitable for IGNITE.

Fluency in English is essential. Delegates need to discuss their businesses with mentors, contributors and fellow IGNITE participants during the week and must pitch their ideas in English.

Delegates must be prepared to commit one week of their time to an intensive programme. If you don't attend all the required sessions we cannot award you the IGNITE Cerificate at the end of the week.
