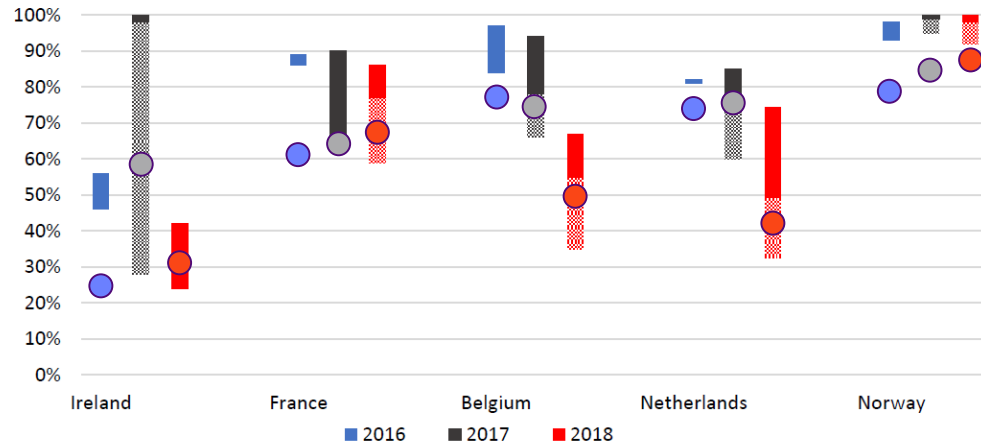
Participation of Cross-Border Capacity

Interconnectors have made a substantial contribution to security of supply historically and will continue to do so into the future

The current low de-rating factors undervalue the future contribution of interconnectors to security of supply

Consumers pay a significant cost when interconnectors are undervalued

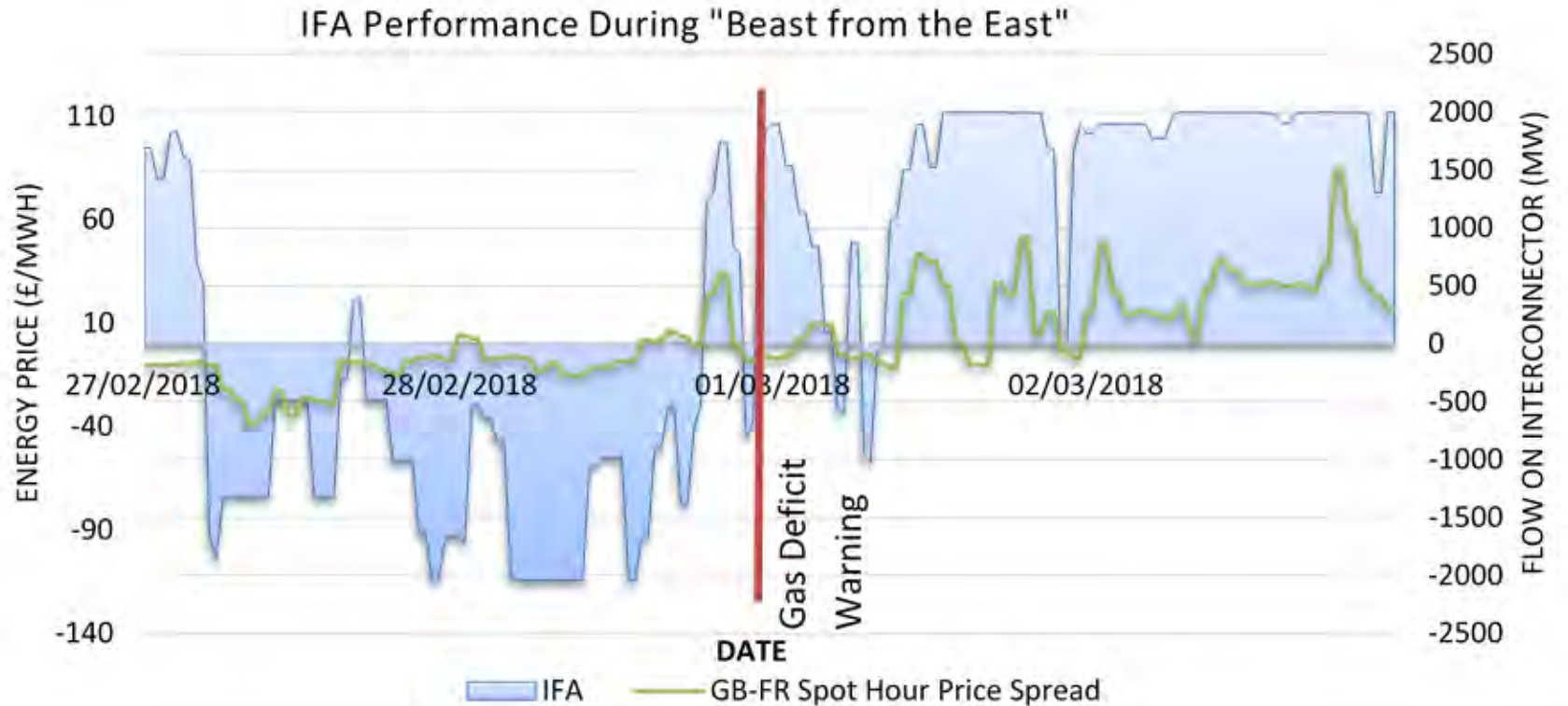
Figure 16: T-4 Forward De-rating Factor Ranges (2018,2017,2016)



Derating factors are consistently set at the lower end of forecasts driven by pessimistic sensitivities and not the FES scenarios.

We think this undervalues cross-border capacity requiring additional unnecessary capacity to be procured
