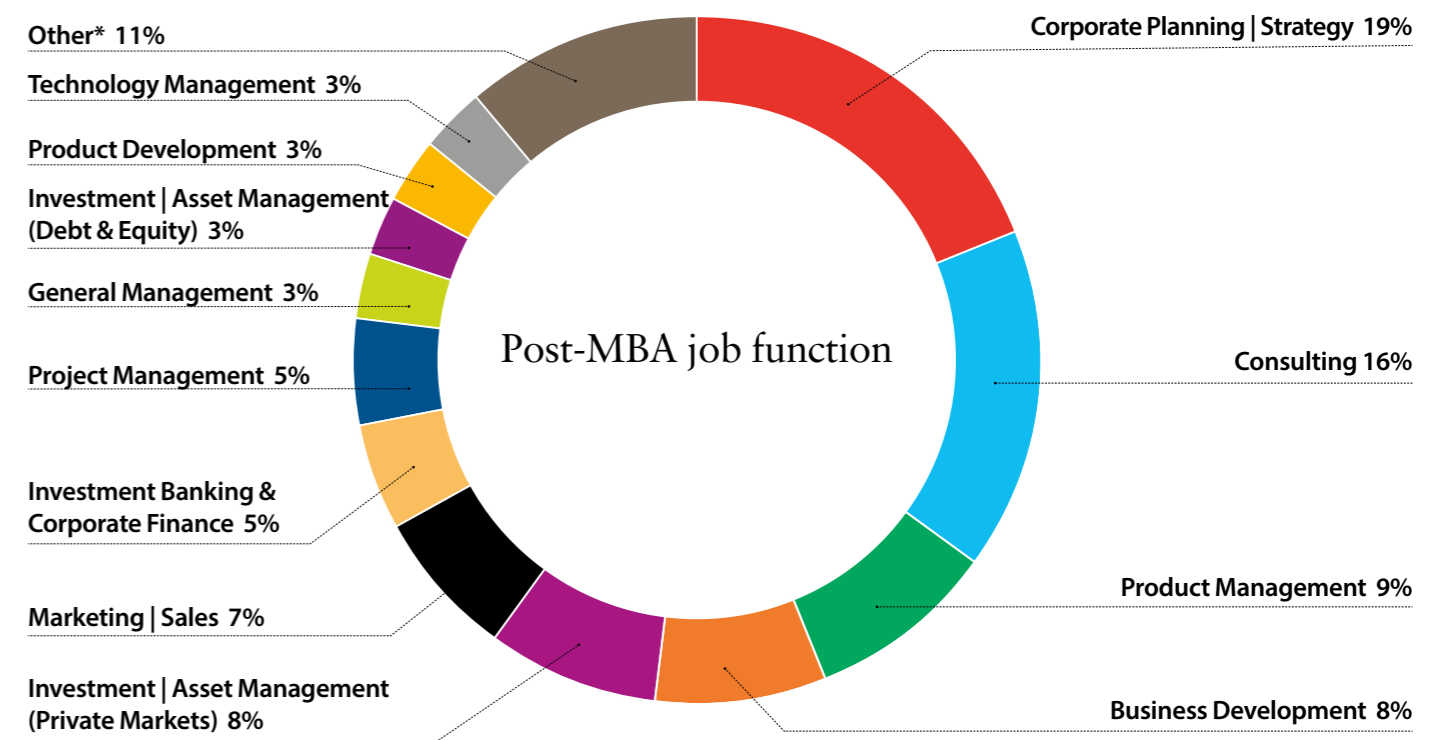

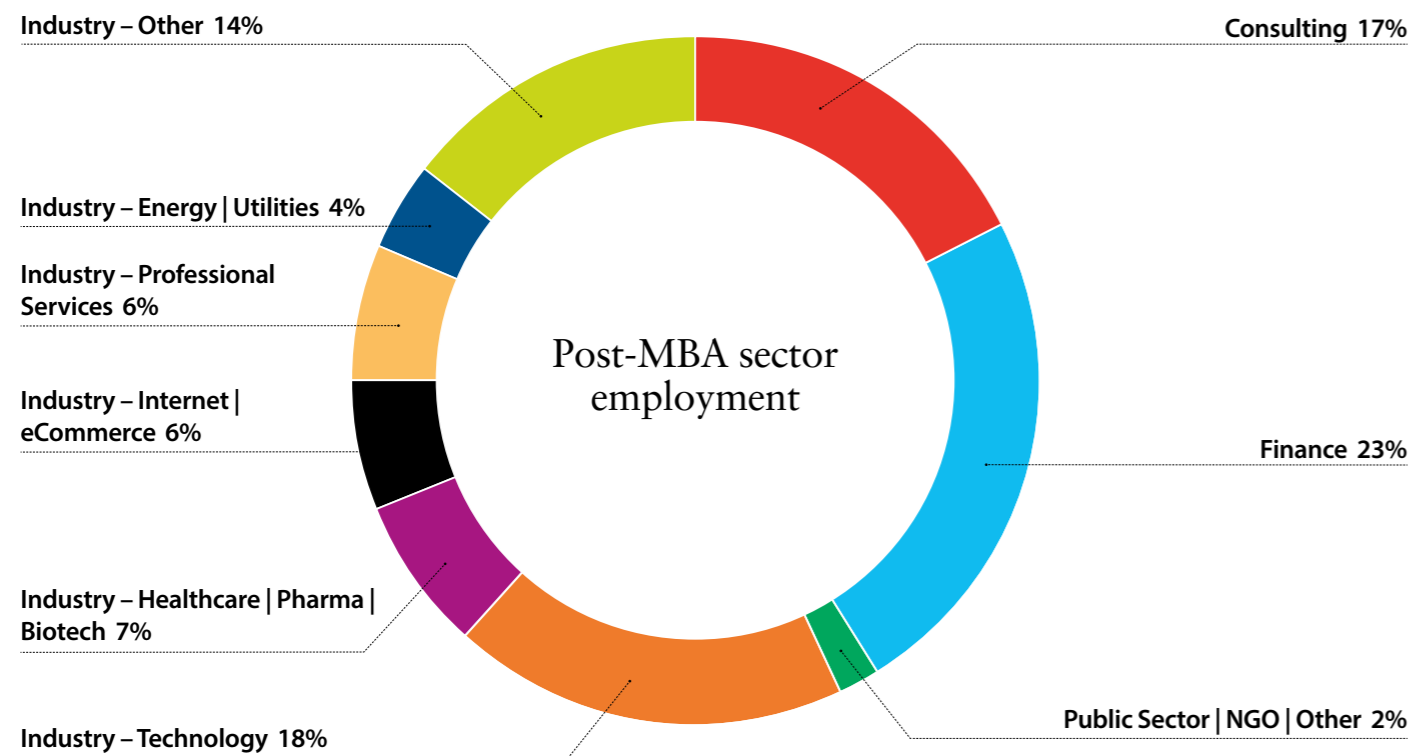


Post-MBA | Job function

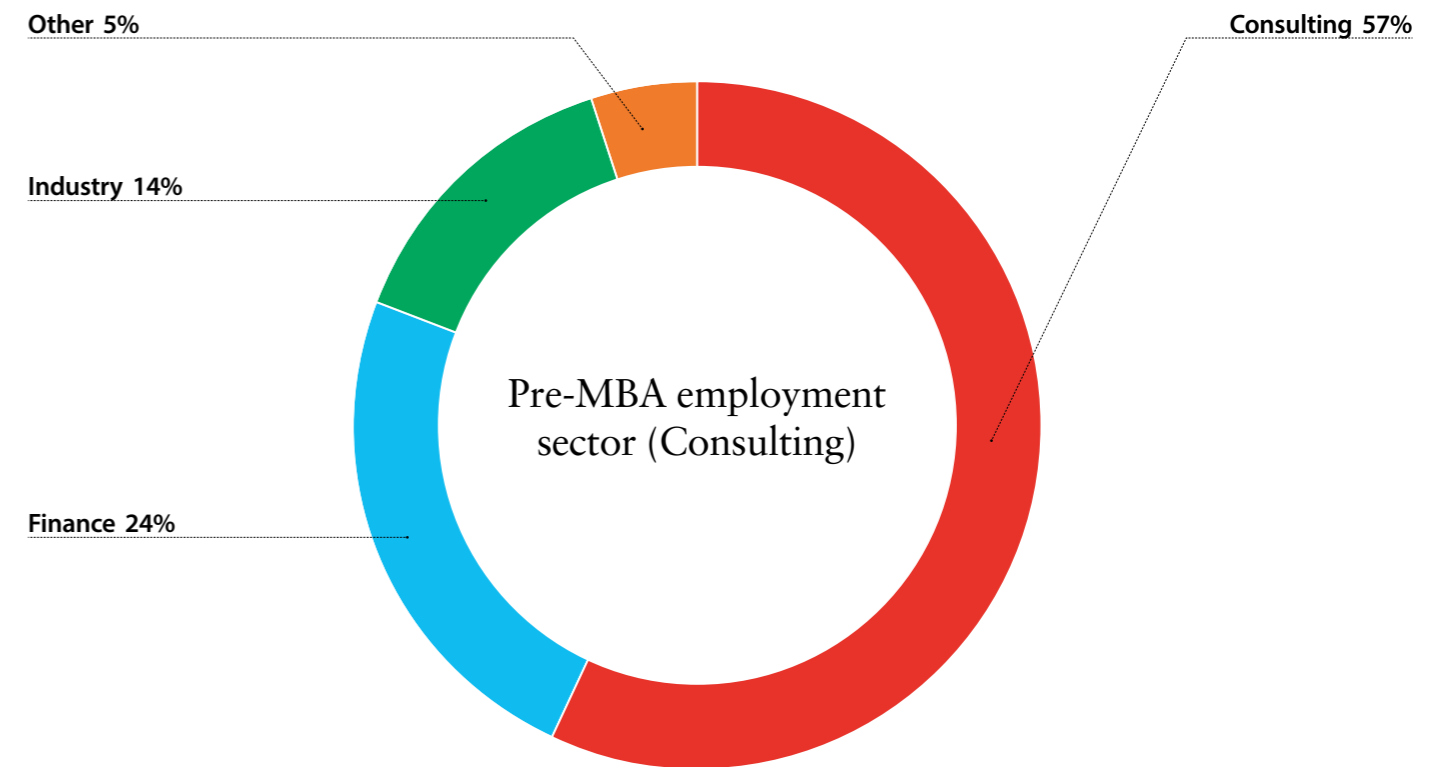

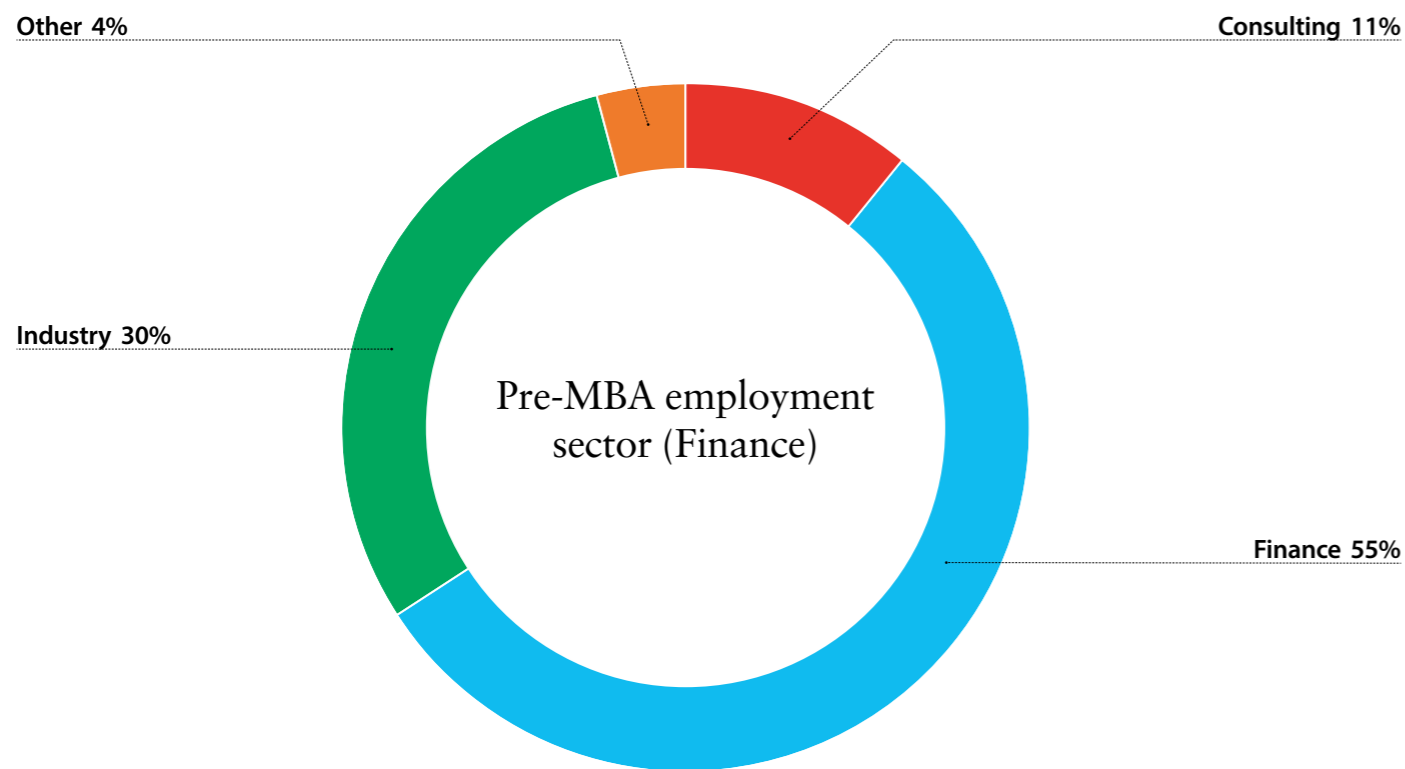

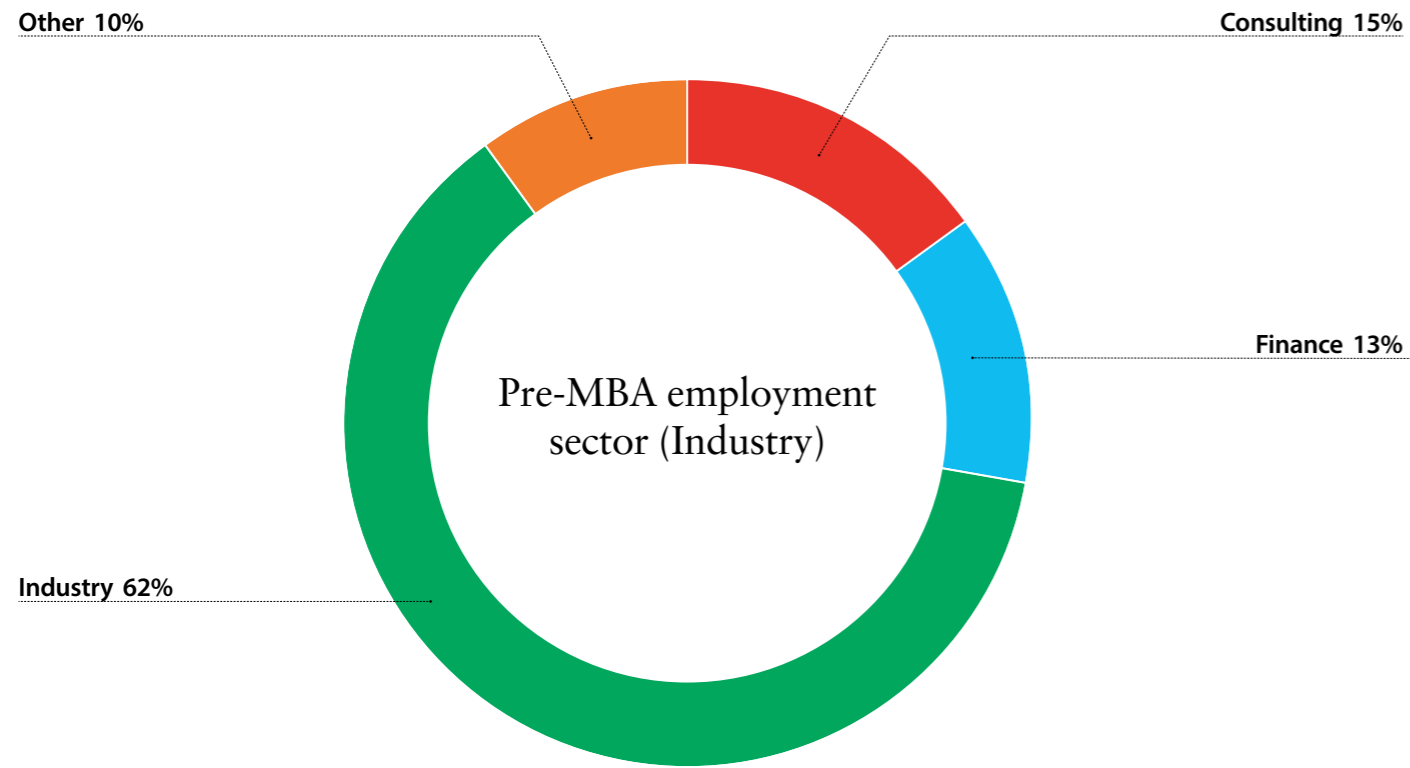

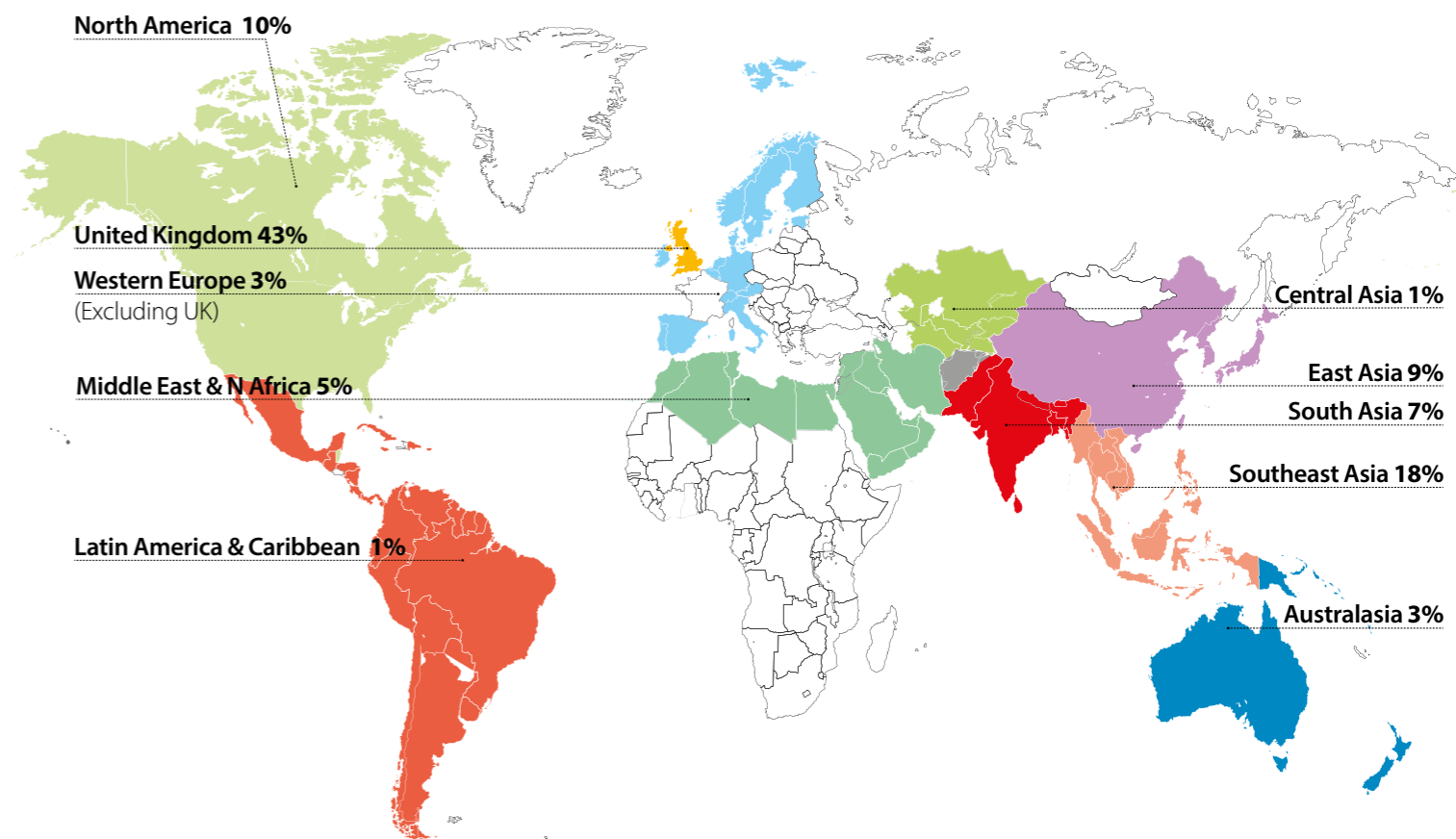
